### **Lighting Columns**

There has been some structural testing of street lamps in the Whitestone/Bulkington area and some have failed the tests. All columns over 25 years old are having the steel tested. They are then being replaced with the latest standard which is a six metre high column and a 45 watt white lamp. They provide a better light source and colour definition and also are more energy efficient. They have had very little adverse feedback on them to date

### **Bulkington Library**

At the Warwickshire County Council Cabinet meeting on 13<sup>th</sup> October it was agreed that a community library would be established in the premises of the current County Council library in Bulkington on the provision that all the funding and delivery arrangements proposed are secured.

The WCC provision will close on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2012; it is hoped that the new facility which will include a café, internet café, rooms for hire and continuing library services will be up and running as soon after this as possible.
